

# *ring size guide*

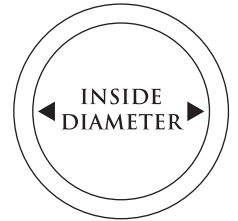
CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

- PRIOR TO PRINTING, ENSURE THAT PAGE SCALING IS SET TO "NONE".
- MEASURE THE BAR ON THE RIGHT, IT MUST BE EXACTLY 30 MM LONG.



## MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.  
Engagement and wedding rings are traditionally worn on the left hand.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.  
This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.  
Rings with stones or patterns all the way around usually cannot be resized, it is more secure to order larger size.

## TIPS FOR MEASURING RING SIZE

### MEASURING YOUR FINGER

1. Ring should fit your finger comfortably; snug enough so that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.
2. Finger size changes depending on the time of day and the weather. For best results measure your finger size:
  - At the end of the day and when your fingers are warm (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold.)
  - Measure finger size 3 to 4 times to eliminate an erroneous reading.
3. Avoid using string or paper to measure ring size as these materials can stretch or twist, yielding an inaccurate measurement.
